

These instructions are to be read as part of the printed Sailing Instructions (RPYC Sailing Handbook).

Division of Fleets:

Boats in divisions A, B and C will be allocated into fleets in relation to their Wednesday fleets or their usual Saturday fleet.

The handicaps published on the online RPYC notice board will show your fleet allocation if you are unaware.

If you are still unsure of which division, you should be sailing in please contact the Boating Office at RPYC.

Start / Finish Line:

Line "A"

Division Flags:

Division A – Code Flag A

Division B – Code Flag B

Division C – Code Flag C



Boats are not required to carry their class / division flags.

Course Signals:

The course to be sailed by each division will be designated by the display of the appropriate International Numeral Pennant prior to the first warning signal.

Day Buoy:

If specified in the course, a **Day Buoy** will be used as per 13.2 in the Red Book.

Time Limit:

Boats failing to finish by 1700 will be scored "Did Not Finish (DNF)"

Shortened Course:

Courses may be shortened in accordance with RRS 32 **or** by the following method:

As the leading boat of any division approaches Knot Spit, Flag 'S' will be displayed at Start/Finish Line "A" with two sound signals accompanied by a flashing light. All boats in all divisions will then proceed directly to the finish at Finish Line "A" in a north westerly direction.

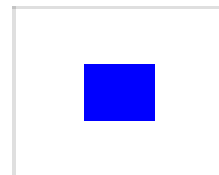

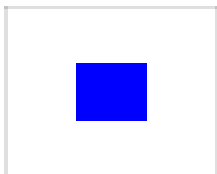
