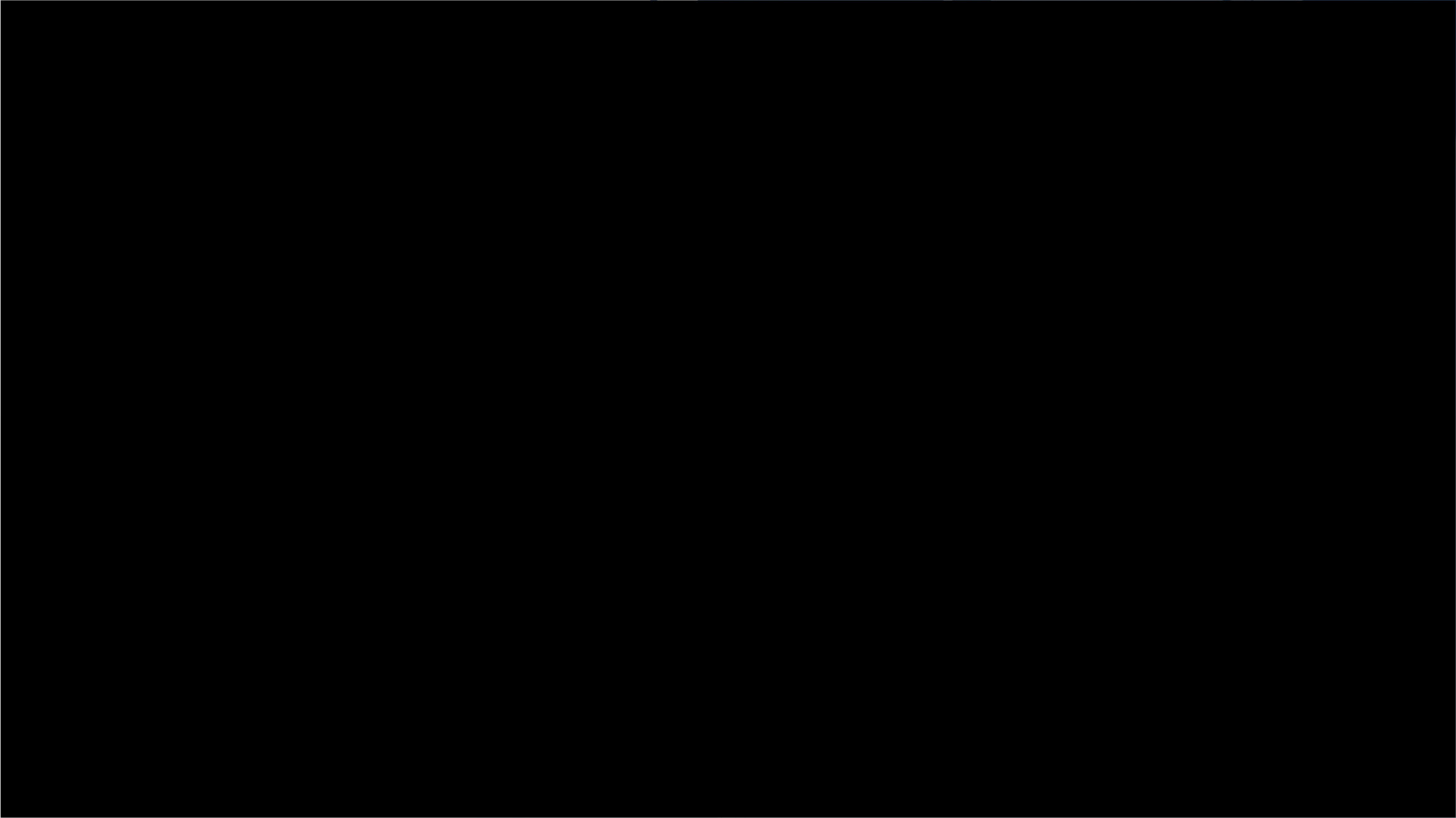




SAILOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, OTB PATHWAYS and OTB Strategic Plan

SUPPORTING RPYC SAILORS TO REACH PEAK PERFORMANCE







The first step in the RPYC Keelboat pathway is the Australian Sailing Crew & Helm Course.

This course teaches the participants all the basics required to take part in sailing a Keelboat.

The Sailor Development Program (SDP) is a series of programs to assist people who have completed the Keelboat Crew and Helm course, or have equivalent sailing experience, to develop their sailing skills to be “race-ready” as crew, and also go on to skipper a sailing boat.

The RPYC Racing Skills program is as the name suggests, this program focuses on key skills required for racing at Club, State or National Level competition.

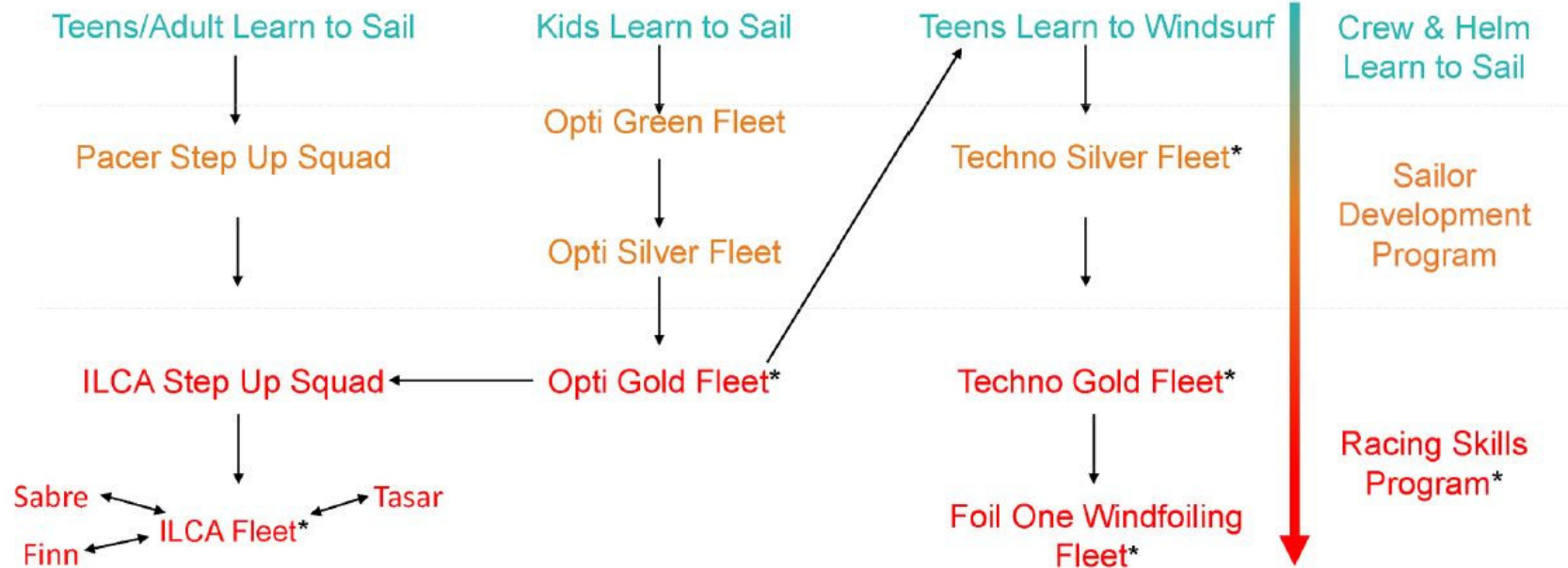
The racing skills program is where sailors build on skills from previous programs putting them to use in a simulated racing environment.
