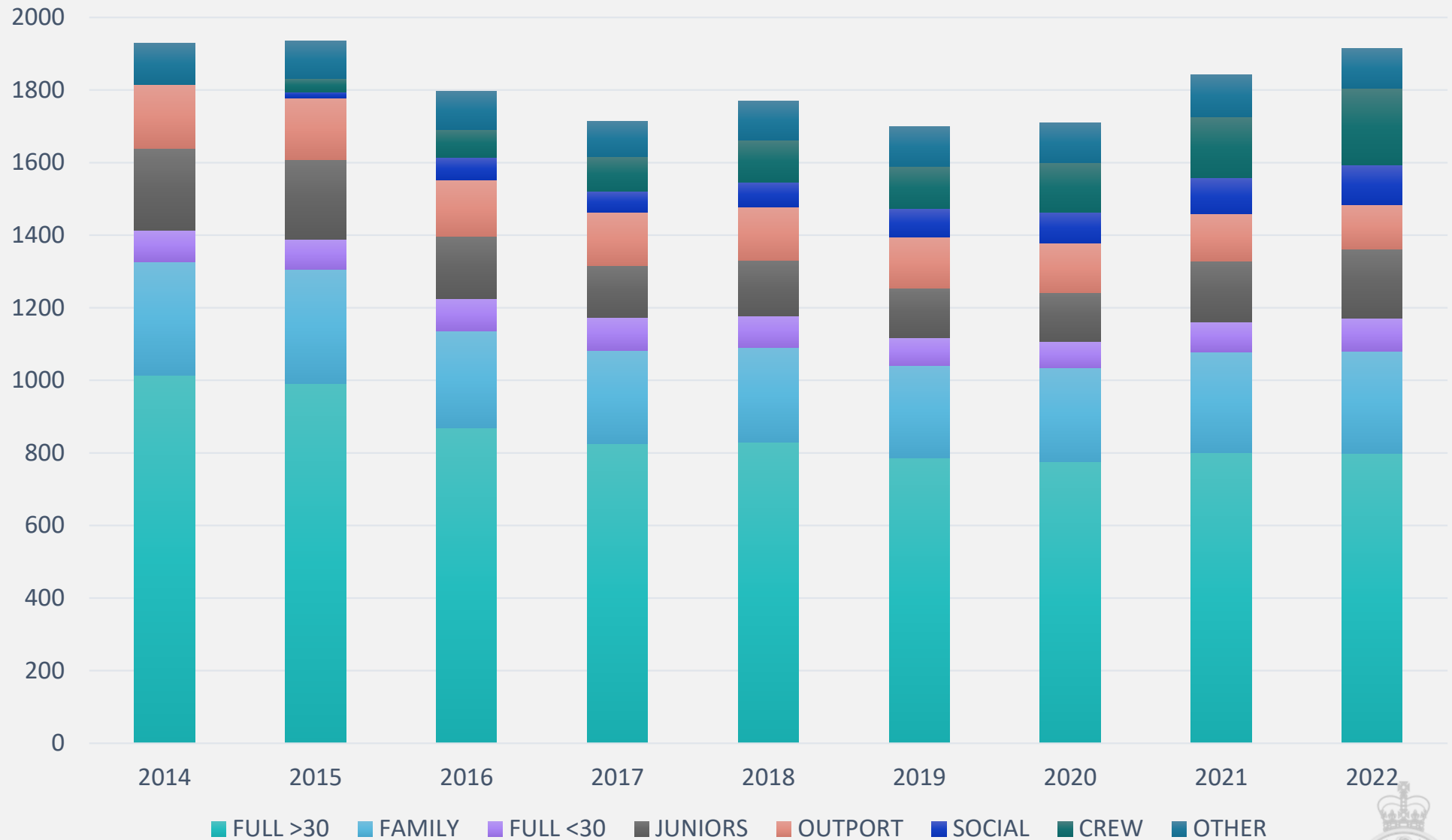


Infrastructure Improvements around the Club

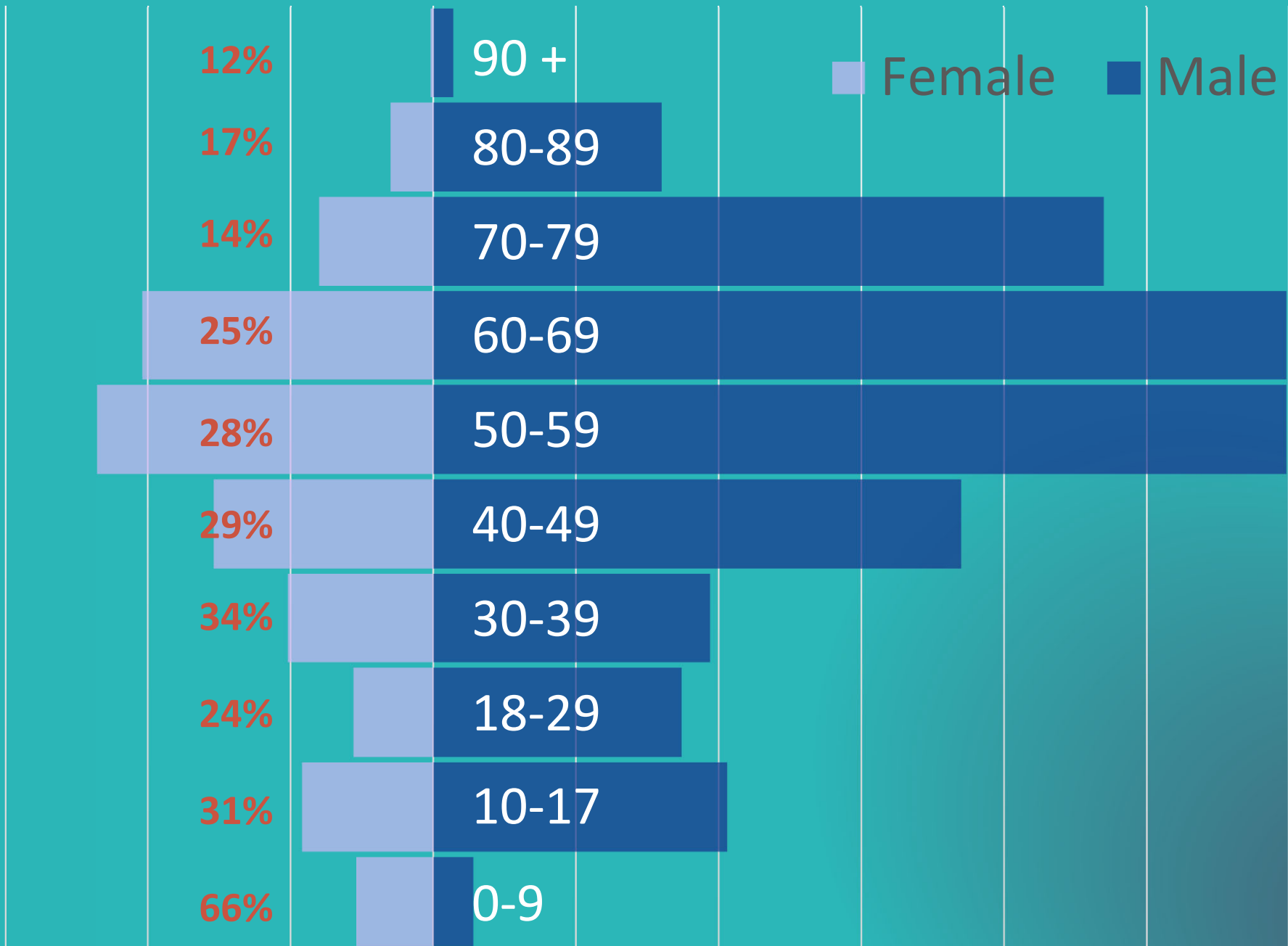
- Revitalization of Fremantle Annexe

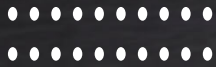
