All Members are encouraged to attend the Annual General Meeting of Royal Perth Yacht Club on Thursday 10th August 2023 at 1900 hrs. Full Members, Full Family Members, Permanent and Honorary Life Members shall be entitled to vote.

“Unfinancial Members” are ineligible to hold office or vote at any General Meeting of the Club.

“Unfinancial Members” are defined in the Club’s Constitution 2021.

Clause 32 (5) and 31 (6):

“(5) For the purpose of sub-clause (6), “Unfinancial Member” means any member who after 45 days from the due date for payment has not paid their annual subscription or any instalment thereof, or any call or levy pursuant to Clause 33 or any other amount due to the Club by that Member.

(6) An unfinancial Member shall not:

- (a) Hold any office or be elected to hold any office whether upon the General Committee or otherwise.
- (b) Vote at any General Meeting.”

This means any amount due and payable to the Club as at July 1, 2023, which is still outstanding on August 10, 2023, disqualifies a Member from voting at the AGM.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Explanatory Memorandum is intended to provide Members of the Club with information to assess the merits of the proposed Resolution contained in the accompanying Notice.

The Explanatory Memorandum should be read in conjunction with the accompanying Notice of Meeting and Notice of Motions.

PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS – AMENDMENTS TO THE RPYC CONSTITUTION 2021:

- In accordance with the Club's Constitution 2021, Clause 33(1), the Committee propose:
“That a Capital Improvement Contribution be imposed on each Full Member of \$20 per calendar month for 12 calendar months beginning on 1st September 2023, ending on 31st August 2024. All other Member category contributions will be adjusted in accordance with subscription fees as set in the Club's By-Laws, Section 8, Clause 8.2.3, Clause 8.2.4 and Clause 8.2.5.”

Background:

The upcoming financial year is full of challenges and uncertainties.

The introduction of this short-term measure is to provide the ability for the Club to undertake some short-term capital projects that will provide benefits to all members. The funds raised are only to be used for these measures with the full details of what is to be accomplished communicated at the Annual General Meeting on August 10th.

Rather than increase subscriptions to raise these funds, the contribution will not increase the base subscriptions that would be otherwise subject to indexation at a later time.

This measure also ensures that those who will start to receive the benefits of the capital projects delivered by this motion will also pay for the motion immediately and not leave a financial legacy to be dealt with by the members present in the future.

If this motion fails, it is unlikely that these short-term capital projects will be delivered.

- The re-wording of the Club's By-Laws Section 8.3.2.1 referring to House Support Scheme to read:

“The House Support Levy annual cost to contributing members shall be \$385 which will be debited to members' accounts at the rate of \$192.50 per six-month period, in advance.”

This Levy can be increased in any year in line with the annual rate of inflation for Perth (Capital City) (all groups index numbers) as at the March Quarter each year as determined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. The specific reference for the Perth Inflation number and the type of Members to which this fee applies can be amended by the General Committee as required.

Background:

The upcoming financial year is full of challenges and uncertainties.

The Club needs to ensure all revenue sources are moving in line with inflation to combat the challenges.

The HSS only applies to Full, Social and Centreboard Members. As per By-Law 8.3.3, Full Members between the age of 24 and 27 and Centreboard Members are only required 50% of the published rate. General Committee can provide a reduced amount of HSS for those who request it, this is on a case-by-case basis at a General Committee meeting.

The inflationary reference is to provide the GC the ability to increase the HSS by a maximum of CPI from one year to the next. There is no obligation for the GC to increase the HSS fee every year. This can be determined as part of the budget process.

The HSS is effectively only paid by the relevant Members who do not utilise Food and Beverage or Pro Shop at the Club.

Recent changes to the F&B offerings should entice Members to support the Club more often.

- **The addition of Clause 4(1)(k) – Corporate Members**
- **Insert new Clause 15 - Corporate Member and the re-numbering of subsequent clauses.**

15. CORPORATE MEMBER:

- (1) 'Corporate Member', means an Australian Registered Business which has been elected as a Corporate Member in accordance with the provisions of this Constitution.
- (2) An Australian Registered Business shall not be eligible unless it has an Australian Company Number and is elected as prescribed by Clause 17.
- (3) A Corporate Member shall cease to be a Corporate Member of the Club upon ceasing to have an Australian Company Number. Corporate Membership shall also cease if the entity is or has an Administrator, Receiver or Liquidator appointed or comes under any other analogous form of external administration.
- (4) A Corporate Member may not nominate to Corporate Membership without the written authorisation by a duly authorised officer of the candidate company agreeing to be bound to the provisions of this Constitution and any By-Laws made thereunder as respectively in force at the time of such nomination and as may be thereafter added to, altered or varied from time to time.
- (5) A Corporate Member shall be entitled to exercise all the rights and privileges of a Full Member except that a Corporate Member:
 - (a) may not vote at any General Meeting of the Club;
 - (b) shall be ineligible for election to the General Committee of the Club;

- (c) may not nominate or second any candidate for any class of membership in the Club;
- (d) may not nominate or second any member for any office of the Club or
- (e) may not register a boat on the Club's Vessel Register.
- (6) The number of Corporate Memberships shall not exceed fifty (50) at any one point in time.
- (7) A Corporate Membership subscription includes the following classes of membership whom shall be elected as prescribed by Clause 17:
 - (a) One (1) Full or Family Membership at any time and, or
 - (b) Four (4) Social Memberships at any time
 - (c) Each Full and Social Membership allocation provided to Corporate Members can only be changed twice within a fiscal year.
- (8) The annual subscription of a Corporate Member will always be a minimum of five (5) times that of a Full Member.
- (9) A Corporate Member shall be entitled to receive notice of, and its delegate may attend, any General Meeting of the Club.
- (10) Benefits received cannot be transferred to unrelated entities or persons.

17. ELECTION OF FULL MEMBERS, FAMILY MEMBERS, CENTREBOARD MEMBERS, JUNIOR MEMBERS, SOCIAL MEMBERS, CREW MEMBERS, OUTPORT MEMBERS, CORPORATE MEMBERS AND RECIPROCAL MEMBERS:

- (1) This clause applies to the election of Full Members, Family Members, Centreboard Members, Junior Members, Social Members, Crew Members, Outport Members, Corporate Members and Reciprocal Members.
- (2) A reference in this clause to "Member" includes "Full Member", "Family Member", "Centreboard Member", "Junior Member", "Social Member", "Crew Member", "Outport Member", "Corporate Member" and "Reciprocal Member".
- (3) In addition to any other provisions of this Constitution a person or company shall not be eligible for election as a Member unless:

The Corporate sponsorship will introduce new members by allowing one Full and four Social members of the Club. These memberships will also have varied offers to entice a Corporate Member to causally entertain its stakeholders at the Club or hold formal functions within the Club.

The Constitution makes no reference for entrance fees, however these can be dealt with by the By-Laws if this modification to the Constitution is successful.

Any Corporate Membership offers can be controlled by the General Committee via the Management Limitations Policy and reviewed annually.

- **The re-wording of the Club's Constitution:**

That Clause 9(5)(c) of the Constitution be amended as follows:

Clause 9(5)(c) – “Centreboard Members may only nominate or second candidates for ‘Centreboard’, ‘Social’, ‘Social Family’ or Junior’ membership of the Club”.

That Clause 11(2)(c) of the Constitution be amended to read:

Clause 11(2)(c) – “Social Members may only nominate or second candidates for ‘Centreboard’, ‘Social’, ‘Social Family’ or Junior’ membership of the Club”.

That Clause 12(2) of the Constitution be amended to read:

Clause 12(2) – “A Crew Member must be nominated by the current skipper of the boat on which the person crews or must be nominated by a Member of General Committee”.

Clause 16 (3) – “In addition to any other provisions of this Constitution a person shall not be eligible for election as a Member unless:

- (a) the candidate for election has been nominated for membership by an Honorary Life Member, Full Member, or Outport Member and that nomination is seconded by an Honorary Life Member, Full Member, or Outport Member. Social and Centreboard Members may only nominate or second candidates as per Clause 9 (5)(c) and Clause 11(2)(c).

HONORARY TREASURER'S REPORT

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY, 2023

I am very pleased to report a substantial improvement in the financial performance of your Club for the year ended 31 May 2023.

A key focus during the year has been improving the Club's cash flow situation and developing plans to ensure the Club's financial sustainability. Initiatives have included:

- developing balanced pricing policies
- maintaining strong cost controls
- suspending capital redevelopment
- negotiating a favourable bank loan repayment schedule
- preparing comprehensive budgets and cash flow forecasts
- strategic planning to identify short and medium-term actions, priorities, and goals

Due to the substantial improvement in financial performance, the General Committee is satisfied that the going concern basis of preparation for the Annual Financial Statements 2022/23 is appropriate.

LEADERSHIP

In February 2023, we had the pleasure of welcoming aboard our new General Manager, Rick Coate. Since taking the helm Rick has worked hard to develop a strong sense of shared purpose between the General Committee, Management, the Team and Members. We look forward to his continued leadership in navigating us to achieving our shared goals.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

- Loss for the year was \$158,318, a significant improvement from the previous year's loss of \$760,831
- Net debt¹ was reduced during the year by \$1,255,171 and at 31 May 23 is \$5,374,278
- Operating cash flow improved to \$2,293,492 from \$1,231,738 in the previous year
- Hospitality operations generated a profit of \$249,886 compared to a loss in the previous year of \$230,170

FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE

During the year ended 31 May 2023, a loss of (\$158,318) (2022 - loss: (\$760,831)) including depreciation of (\$1,575,687) (2022 - (\$1,453,215)) was incurred from continuing operations. The result for the year can be summarised as Revenue \$7,839,899 (up \$892,470 on previous year) and Expenditure \$7,361,598 (up \$222,990 on previous year).

Income from pen and hardstand fees increased to \$3,195,124 (2022 - \$3,066,276), with pen occupancy continuing to perform strongly.

Hospitality operations generated a profit of \$249,886 (2022 - loss: (\$230,179)).

These positive results generated an operating cash flows of \$2,293,492 (2022 - \$1,231,738) and after investing and financing cash flows a cash position of \$666,592 (2022: \$17,756) resulted.

LIQUIDITY

Current liabilities are in excess of current assets by \$2,317,975 (2022 - \$3,258,286). It should be noted however, that this includes:

- \$85,553 in function deposits which will convert to income at the time the function is held;
- \$76,126 income in advance relating to pen fees (\$70,596) and rent (\$5,530);
- borrowings of \$591,984 (2022 - \$1,056,335) reflecting the commitment to loan repayments over the next twelve months; and,
- \$1,814,600 from 382 pen deposits refundable only when pens are vacated.

After considering the finance facilities available to the Club, the assets of the Club, its ongoing trading performance, and the mix of the Club's liabilities, the General Committee believes that the Club will not have any difficulty paying its liabilities as and when they become due for payment.

GENERAL

Our ongoing objective continues to be to consolidate the Club's financial position and prepare plans for the next stage of development at the Club.

I would like to take this opportunity to extend my thanks to the General Committee members, and the Management Team and in particular Neil Smith (Financial Controller), who is responsible for the day to day financial management of the Club and preparing the routine financial reports to enable the General Committee to exercise oversight of the Club's financial affairs.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS

1. CORPORATE INFORMATION

The Royal Perth Yacht Club of Western Australia (Inc) is a club incorporated and domiciled in Western Australia. The address of its registered office and its principal place of business is Australia II Drive, Crawley.

The Financial Report of the Royal Perth Yacht Club for the year ended 31 May 2023 was authorised for issue in accordance with a resolution of the General Committee.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Preparation

The Financial Report is a general-purpose Financial Report which has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards.

The Report has been prepared using the historical cost basis, except where stated.

The Report is presented in Australian dollars.

Going Concern

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis which contemplates the continuity of normal business activity and the realisation of assets and the settlement of liabilities in the normal course of business.

At 31 May 2023, the Club reported a deficit of \$158,318 (FY22 deficit: \$760,831) and its current liabilities exceeds its current assets by \$2,317,975 (FY22 restated current liabilities liability position: \$3,258,286). This is impacted by the AASB 101 requirement to report items such as pen occupancy deposits as current liabilities. At 31 May 2023, the Club reported pen occupancy deposits of \$1,814,600 (FY22: \$1,646,692) as current liabilities. It should be noted that this relates to 382 pen deposits, which are only refundable when pens are vacated.

The balance sheet includes total debt of \$6,040,870 (FY22: \$6,647,205) of which \$5,738,738 is on a variable interest rate agreement subject to interest rates volatility. During the year ended 31 May 2023, the Australian cash rate has increased from 0.35% as at 31 May 2022 to 3.85% as at 31 May 2023.

During May 2023, the Club renegotiated principal repayments of the bank facility. The renegotiated principal repayments are listed below:

Under the latest bank facility agreement, two further repayments of \$250,000 are due in May 2025 and November 2025. The remaining balance of \$4,488,738 becomes due and payable at the expiration of the term of the loan facilities in May 2026. The Club intends to negotiate a new loan facility prior to the expiration of the term.

In addition, the Club has \$302,132 remaining on its Elliott yacht loan facility, in which the Club makes repayments of \$8,430 per month. The term of this facility expires in July 2026.

During the year ended 31 May 2023, the Club met its banking covenants and generated cash from operations of \$2,293,492 (FY22: \$1,231,738). The Club is forecasting an operating deficit of \$115,424 (FY23 deficit: \$158,318) and cash inflow from operating activities of \$1,107,927 (FY23: \$2,293,492).

The Club's cash flow forecast for the next 12 months to May 2024, reflects the Club's capacity to deploy the available resources to achieve its objectives. The achievement of the forecasts is materially dependent on the following key assumptions:

- Acceptance by the AGM of increased membership fees;
- Hospitality continuing to operate commercially at break even;
- Increased earnings from the boat lifter following repairs during the FY2023;
- No significant change to the interest rates within the next 12 months; and,
- Continued financial support from the bank over the ensuing 12 months.

The General Committee believe that it is appropriate to prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis. The General Committee is of the opinion that no asset is likely to be realised for an amount less than the amount at which it is recorded in the financial report as at 31 May 2023. Accordingly, the financial report does not include any adjustment relating to the recoverability of classification of the asset carrying amount or the amount and classification of liabilities that might be necessary if the Club is unable to continue as a going concern.

Statement of Compliance

The general purpose financial statements of the Club have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 2015, Australian Accounting Standards and other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board. A statement of compliance with the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) cannot be made due to the Club applying not-for-profit specific requirements contained in the Australian Accounting Standards.

New Standards and Interpretations

The Club has adopted all of the new and revised Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ("AASB") that are relevant to its operations and effective for the current financial year. The adoption of these new and revised Standards and Interpretations did not have any effect on the financial position or performance of the Club.

These new and revised standards are not expected to have any material effect on the financial statements.

Financial instruments

A financial instrument is any contract that gives rise to a financial asset of one entity and a financial liability or equity instrument of another entity.

(i) Financial assets

Initial recognition and measurement

Financial assets are classified, at initial recognition, as subsequently measured at amortised cost, fair value through other comprehensive income (OCI), and fair value through profit or loss.

The classification of financial assets at initial recognition depends on the financial asset's contractual cash flow characteristics and the Club's business model for managing them. With the exception of trade receivables that do not contain a significant financing component or for which the Club has applied the practical expedient, the Club initially measures a financial asset at its fair value plus, in the case of a financial asset not at fair value through profit or loss, transaction costs.

In order for a financial asset to be classified and measured at amortised cost or fair value through OCI, it needs to give rise to cash flows that are 'solely payments of principal and interest (SPPI)' on the principal amount outstanding. This assessment is referred to as the SPPI test and is performed at an instrument level.

The Club's business model for managing financial assets refers to how it manages its financial assets in order to generate cash flows. The business model determines whether cash flows will result from collecting contractual cash flows, selling the financial assets, or both.

Subsequent measurement

For purposes of subsequent measurement, financial assets are classified in four categories:

- Financial assets at amortised cost (debt instruments)
- Financial assets at fair value through OCI with recycling of cumulative gains and losses (debt instruments)
- Financial assets designated at fair value through OCI with no recycling of cumulative gains and losses upon derecognition (equity instruments)
- Financial assets at fair value through profit or loss.

Financial assets at amortised cost (debt instruments)

This category is the most relevant to the Club. The Club measures financial assets at amortised cost if both of the following conditions are met:

- The financial asset is held within a business model with the objective to hold financial assets in order to collect contractual cash flows; and
- The contractual terms of the financial asset give rise on specified dates to cash flows that are solely payments of principal and interest on the principal amount outstanding

Financial assets at amortised cost are subsequently measured using the effective interest (EIR) method and are subject to impairment. Gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss when the asset is derecognised, modified or impaired.

The Club's financial assets at amortised cost includes cash and cash equivalents and trade and other receivables.

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

(i) Financial assets continued

Derecognition

A financial asset (or, where applicable, a part of a financial asset or part of a group of similar financial assets) is primarily derecognised when:

- The rights to receive cash flows from the asset have expired; or
- The Club has transferred its rights to receive cash flows from the asset or has assumed an obligation to pay the received cash flows in full without material delay to a third party under a 'pass-through' arrangement; and either (a) the Club has transferred substantially all the risks and rewards of the asset, or (b) the Club has neither transferred nor retained substantially all the risks and rewards of the asset, but has transferred control of the asset.

When the Club has transferred its rights to receive cash flows from an asset or has entered into a pass-through arrangement, it evaluates if, and to what extent, it has retained the risks and rewards of ownership. When it has neither transferred nor retained substantially all of the risks and rewards of the asset, nor transferred control of the asset, the Club continues to recognise the transferred asset to the extent of its continuing involvement. In that case, the Club also recognises an associated liability. The transferred asset and the associated liability are measured on a basis that reflects the rights and obligations that the Club has retained.

Impairment of financial assets

The Club recognises an allowance for expected credit losses (ECLs) for all debt instruments not held at fair value through profit or loss. ECLs are based on the difference between the contractual cash flows due in accordance with the contract and all the cash flows that the Club expects to receive, discounted at an approximation of the original effective interest rate.

ECLs are recognised in two stages. For credit exposures for which there has not been a significant increase in credit risk since initial recognition, ECLs are provided for credit losses that result from default events that are possible within the next 12-months (a 12-month ECL). For those credit exposures for which there has been a significant increase in credit risk since initial recognition, a loss allowance is required for credit losses expected over the remaining life of the exposure, irrespective of the timing of the default (a lifetime ECL).

For trade receivables, the Club applies a simplified approach in calculating ECLs. Therefore, the Club does not track changes in credit risk, but instead recognises a loss allowance based on lifetime ECLs at each reporting date. The Club has established a provision matrix that is based on its historical credit loss experience, adjusted for forward-looking factors specific to the debtors and the economic environment.

The Club considers a financial asset in default when contractual payments are 60 days past due. However, in certain cases, the Club may also consider a financial asset to be in default when internal or external information indicates that the Club is unlikely to receive the outstanding contractual amounts in full before taking into account any credit enhancements held by the Club. A financial asset is written off when there is no reasonable expectation of recovering the contractual cash flows.

(ii) Financial liabilities

Initial recognition and measurement

Financial liabilities are classified, at initial recognition, as financial liabilities at fair value through profit or loss, loans and borrowings, and payables.

All financial liabilities are recognised initially at fair value and, in the case of loans and borrowings and payables, net of directly attributable transaction costs.

The Club's financial liabilities include trade and other payables, and loans and borrowings.

Subsequent measurement

The measurement of financial liabilities depends on their classification, as described below:

Financial liabilities at fair value through profit or loss

Financial liabilities at fair value through profit or loss include financial liabilities held for trading and financial liabilities designated upon initial recognition as at fair value through profit or loss.

Financial liabilities are classified as held for trading if they are incurred for the purpose of repurchasing in the near term.

Gains or losses on liabilities held for trading are recognised in the statement of profit or loss.

Financial liabilities designated upon initial recognition at fair value through profit or loss are designated at the initial date of recognition, and only if the criteria in AASB 9: Financial instruments are satisfied. The Club has not designated any financial liability as at fair value through profit or loss.

Financial liabilities at amortised cost

This is the category most relevant to the Club. After initial recognition, interest-bearing loans and borrowings are subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest rate method. Gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss when the liabilities are derecognised as well as through the effective interest rate amortisation process.

Amortised cost is calculated by taking into account any discount or premium on acquisition and fees or costs that are an integral part of the effective interest rate. The effective interest rate amortisation is included as finance costs in the statement of profit or loss.

Derecognition

A financial liability is derecognised when the obligation under the liability is discharged or cancelled or expires. When an existing financial liability is replaced by another from the same lender on substantially different terms, or the terms of an existing liability are substantially modified, such an exchange or modification is treated as the derecognition of the original liability and the recognition of a new liability. The difference in the respective carrying amounts is recognised in the statement of profit or loss.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (CONTINUED)

Revenue from contracts with customers

The core principle of AASB 15 is that revenue recognised on a basis that reflects the transfer of promised goods or services to customers at an amount that reflects the consideration the Association expects to receive in exchange for those goods and services.

Revenue is recognised by applying a five-step model as follows:

1. Identify the contract with the customer
2. Identify the performance obligations
3. Determine the transaction price
4. Allocate the transaction price to the performance obligations
5. Recognise revenue as and when control of the performance obligations is transferred

Generally the timing of the payment for sale and goods and rendering of services corresponds closely to the timing of satisfaction of the performance obligations, however where there is a difference, it will result in the recognition of a receivable, contract asset or contract liability.

None of the revenue streams of the Club have any significant financing terms as there is less than 12 months between receipt of funds and satisfaction of performance obligations.

The revenue recognition policies for the principal revenue streams of the Club are:

Rendering of services

Revenue from the provision of services is recognised over the period in which the services are rendered.

Membership fees

Membership fees are paid monthly. Fee income relating to future years is treated as a contract liability (income in advance).

Contract assets and liabilities

Where the amounts billed to customers are based on the achievement of various milestones established in the contract, the amount recognised as revenue in a given period do not necessarily coincide with the amounts billed.

When an amount of consideration is received from a customer prior to the entity transferring a good or service to the customer, the Club presents the contract as a contract liability.

Significant Accounting Judgements, Estimates and Assumptions

The carrying amount of certain assets and liabilities is often determined based on estimates and assumptions of future events. The key estimates and assumptions that have a significant risk of causing a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of certain assets and liabilities within the next annual reporting year are:

Impairment of non-financial assets

The Club assesses impairment of all assets at each reporting date by evaluating conditions specific to the Club and to the particular asset that may lead to impairment. These include asset performance, technology and economic and political environments. If an impairment trigger exists, the recoverable amount of the asset is determined.

Estimation of useful lives of assets

The estimation of the useful lives of assets has been based on historical experience as well as manufacturers' warranties (for plant and equipment) and turnover policies. In addition, the condition of the assets is assessed at least once every year and considered against the remaining useful life. Adjustments to useful lives are made when considered necessary.

Long service leave

The Club measures long service leave liability based on estimates of future employee retention rates.

Provision for expected credit losses of trade receivables and contract assets.

The Club uses a provision matrix to calculate ECLs for trade receivables and contract assets. The provision rates are based on days past due for groupings of various customer segments that have similar loss patterns (i.e. by geography, product type, customer type and rating, and coverage by letters of credit and other forms of credit insurance).

The provision matrix is initially based on the Club's historical observed default rates. The Club will calibrate the matrix to adjust the historical credit loss experience with forward-looking information. For instance, if forecast economic conditions (i.e. gross domestic product) are expected to deteriorate over the next year which can lead to an increased number of defaults in the manufacturing sector, the historical default rates are adjusted. At every reporting date, the historical observed default rates are updated and changes in the forward-looking estimates are analysed.

The assessment of the correlation between historical observed default rates, forecast economic conditions and ECLs is a significant estimate. The amount of ECLs is sensitive to changes in circumstances and of forecast economic conditions. The Club's historical credit loss experience and forecast of economic conditions may also not be representative of customer's actual default in the future.

Recognition of volunteer services

Management considers the fair value of services provided by members of the Club cannot be reliably measured. Accordingly, management elect not to recognise volunteer services revenue.

Comparative Figures

Various General Ledger accounts were re-classified during the year. Last year's comparative figures may, in some instances, be different from the figures shown in last year's Financial Statements.

Property, Plant and Equipment

All Property, Plant and Equipment, including buildings, are recognised and measured at cost.

Buildings are depreciated on a straight line basis at rates of 3% to 5%. Jetties and Pens are depreciated on a straight line basis at rates of 3%, 3.5% and 10%. Plant and equipment is depreciated on a straight line basis at rates between 5% and 20%. Motor vehicles are depreciated on a straight line basis at 20% and 25%.

Impairment

The carrying values of plant and equipment are reviewed for impairment when events or changes in circumstances indicate the carrying value may not be recoverable.

For an asset that does not generate largely independent cash inflows, the recoverable amount is determined for the cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs.

If any such indication exists and where the carrying values exceed the estimated recoverable amount, the assets or cash-generating units are written down to their recoverable amount.

The recoverable amount of plant and equipment is the greater of fair value less costs to sell and value in use.

Value in use is determined as the depreciated replacement cost of the asset or cash generating units.

Based on the value in use approach, assets of the Club are not impaired.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and short-term deposits in the Statement of Financial Position comprise cash at bank and in hand and short-term deposits of less than 12 months.

For the purposes of the Statement of Cash Flows, cash and cash equivalents consist of cash and cash equivalents as defined above, net of outstanding bank overdrafts.

Inventories

Stock on hand has been valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value on the first in first out basis.

Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the Club has a present obligation (legal or constructive) as a result of a past event, it is probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made of the amount of the obligation.

Provision is made for the Club's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to the balance date.

Employee benefits expected to be settled within one year, together with entitlements arising from wages and salaries and annual leave which will be settled after one year, have been measured at the nominal value. On-costs, other than superannuation, are recorded as a separate provision to employee benefits.

The total employees of the Club at 31 May 2023 was 65 (Full Time: 20, Part Time: 2, Casuals: 43).

Income Tax

The Club is exempt from income tax.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST except:

- Where GST incurred on a purchase of goods and services is not recoverable from the taxation authority, in which case the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of the expense item as applicable; and
- Receivables and payables are stated with the amount of GST included.

Right-of-use assets and associated lease liabilities

Right of use assets

"The right-of-use asset is measured at cost, which comprises the initial amount of the lease liability, adjusted for, as applicable, any lease payments made at or before the commencement date net of any lease incentives received, any initial direct costs incurred and included in an estimate of costs expected to be incurred for dismantling and removing the underlying asset and restoring the site or asset.

Right-of-use assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis over the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful life of the asset, whichever is the shorter. Right-of-use assets are subject to impairment or adjusted for any remeasurement of lease liabilities. The Club has elected not to recognise a right-of-use asset and corresponding lease liability for short-term leases with terms of 12 months or less and leases of low-value assets. Lease payments on these assets are expensed as incurred."

Lease Liabilities

"Lease liability is initially recognised at the present value of the lease payments to be made over the term of the lease, discounted using the interest rate implicit in the lease or, if that rate cannot be readily determined, the Club's incremental borrowing rate. Lease payments comprise fixed payments less lease liabilities and are measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method. The carrying amounts are remeasured if there is a change in the following: future lease payments arising from a change in an index or a rate used; residual guarantee; lease term; certainty of a purchase option and termination penalties. When a lease liability is remeasured, an adjustment is made to the corresponding right-of-use asset, or to profit or loss if the carrying amount of the right-of-use asset is fully written down."

3. FINANCIAL RISK MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES AND POLICIES

The Club's principal financial instruments comprise cash, bank overdrafts, receivables, payables, other payables and its bank bill facility. The Club manages its exposure to key financial risks in accordance with the Club's financial risk management policy. The objective of the policy is to support the delivery of the Club's financial targets whilst protecting future financial security.

The main risks arising from the Club's financial instruments are interest rate risk, liquidity risk and credit risk. The Club uses different methods to measure and manage different types of risks to which it is exposed. These include monitoring levels of exposure to interest rates and assessments of market forecasts for interest rates. Ageing analysis and monitoring of specific credit allowances are undertaken to manage credit risk. Liquidity risk is monitored through the development of future rolling cash flow forecasts.

The General Committee is responsible for the identification and control of financial risks. The General Committee reviews and agrees policies for managing each of these risks and these are summarised below.

Interest Rate Risk

Interest rate risk is the risk that the value of a financial instrument or cash flows associated with the instrument will fluctuate due to changes in market interest rates. Interest rate risk arises from fluctuations in the interest bearing financial assets and liabilities that the Club uses. Interest bearing assets comprise cash and cash equivalents which are considered to be short-term liquid assets. Interest bearing liabilities comprise bank overdrafts and the bank bill facility. It is the Club's policy to settle trade payables within the credit terms allowed and the Club does therefore not incur interest on overdue balances.

Credit Risk

Credit risk is the risk of financial loss to the Club if a customer or counterparty to a financial instrument fails to meet its contractual obligations. The Club is exposed to credit risk on its cash and cash equivalents and trade receivables and other receivables, which also represents the maximum exposure to credit risk. The Club only deposits surplus cash with well established financial institutions of high quality credit standing.

In addition, receivable balances are monitored on an ongoing basis with the result that the Club's exposure to bad debts is not significant.

The Club's approach to managing liquidity is to ensure, as far as possible, that it will always have sufficient liquidity to meet its liabilities when due, under both normal and stressed conditions, without incurring unacceptable losses or risking damage to the Club's reputation.

The Club's objective is to ensure that sufficient funds are available to allow it to continue its activities. Up to 31 May 2023 the Club funded its activities from the provision of goods and services to Members.

Related Party Transactions

5. RESTATEMENT OF PEN OCCUPANCY DEPOSITS

The Club has historically classified pen occupancy deposits as non-current liabilities in line with the cash flow impact experienced from refunding deposits upon relinquishment of pens and receiving new deposits to occupy vacant pens.

During the year, the Club conducted a review of the treatment of these deposits in light of the By-Laws and the requirements of the Australian Accounting Standards. The Club has determined that it does not have unconditional right to defer the refund of liability for at least twelve months after the reporting period, in the event a member relinquishes the pen and requests a refund.

Opinion

We have audited the financial report of Royal Perth Yacht Club of Western Australia (Inc) ('the Club'), which comprises the statement of financial position as at 31 May 2023, the statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income, statement of changes in equity and statement of cash flows for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and the General Committee's Declaration.

In our opinion the accompanying financial report gives a true and fair view of the financial position of the Club as at 31 May 2023, and of its financial performance for the year then ended in accordance with the *Associations Incorporation Act 2015* and the Australian Accounting Standards.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report* section of our report. We are independent of the Club in accordance with the ethical requirements of the Accounting Professional and Ethical Standards Board's APES 110 *Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (including Independence Standards)* ('the Code') that are relevant to our audit of the financial report in Australia. We have also fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Material Uncertainty Related to Going Concern

We draw attention to Note 2 to the financial report, which indicates that the Club had incurred a net deficit of \$158,318 (FY22 deficit: \$760,831) for the year ended 31 May 2023 and, as of that date, the Club's current liabilities exceeded its current assets by \$2,317,975 (FY22 net liability position: \$3,258,286). These events or conditions indicate that a material uncertainty exists that may cast significant doubt on the Club's ability to continue as a going concern. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of General Committee for the Financial Report

General Committee is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in accordance with the financial reporting requirements of the *Associations Incorporation Act 2015* and for such internal control as the General Committee determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, General Committee is responsible for assessing the Club's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless General Committee either intends to liquidate the Club or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so. General Committee is responsible for overseeing the Club's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with the Australian Auditing Standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists.

Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this financial report.
