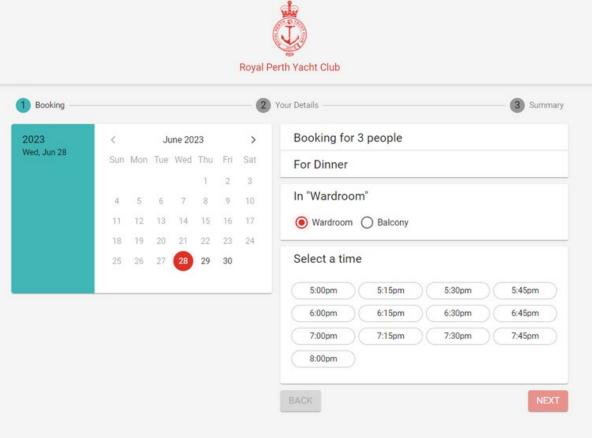

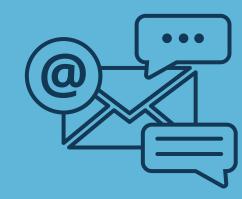
- We reached 290,129 accounts

Over the past year:

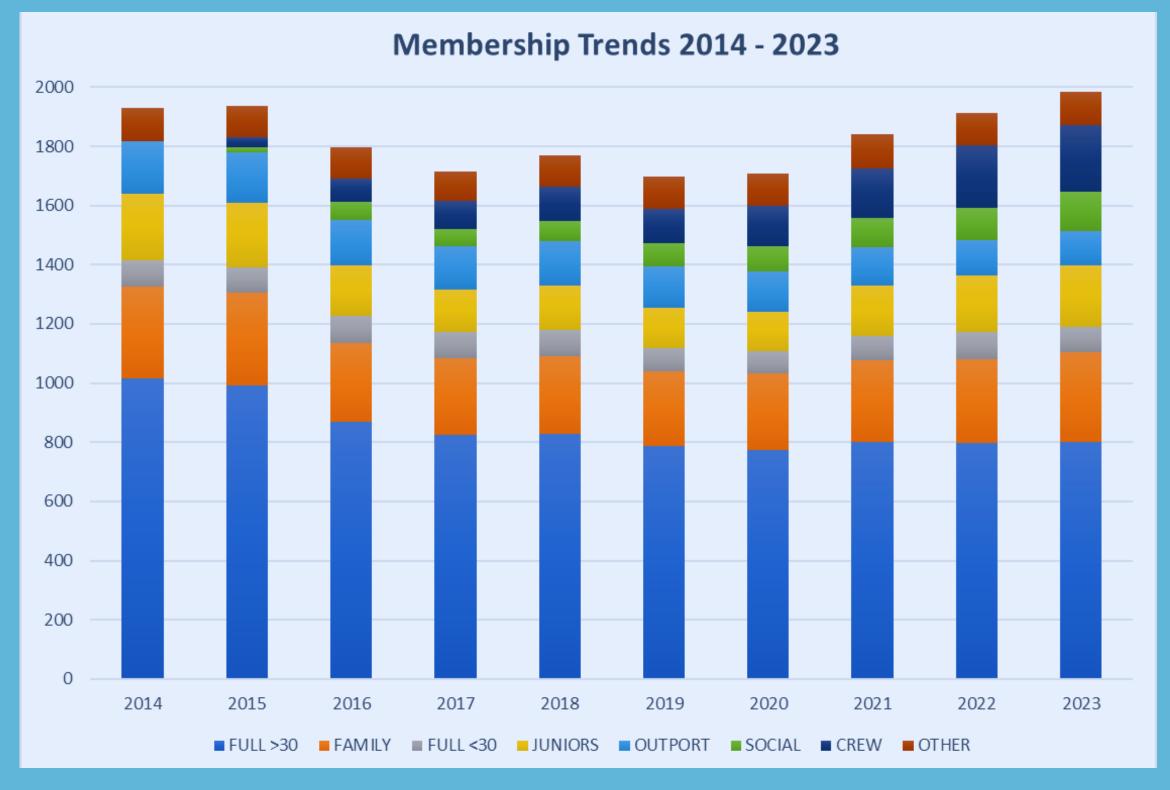
- 55% of our audience often open our EDM's (22% increase)

MEMBERSHIP TRENDS

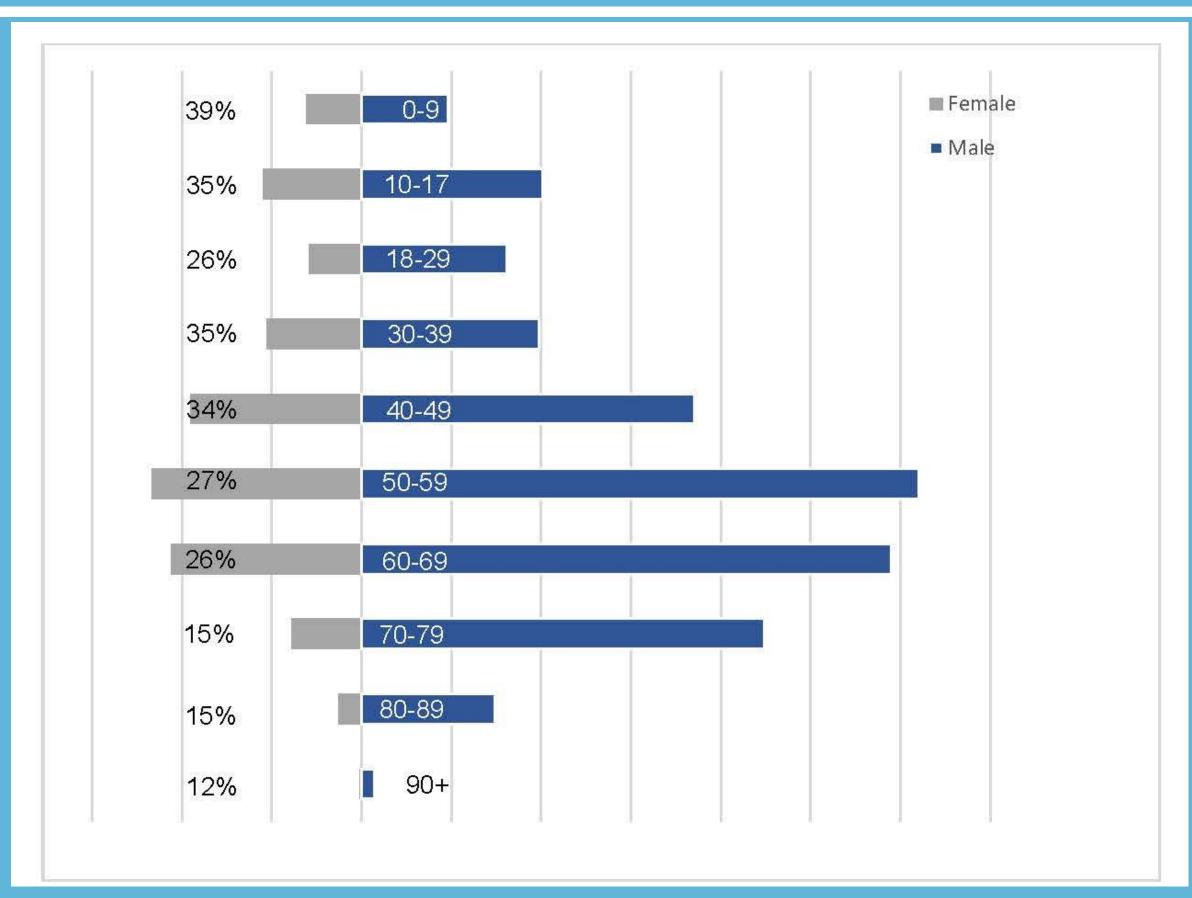






RPYC MEMBERSHIP PYRAMID 2023

What we do:

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m Ho\,w}$: Develop a Sustainability Policy - aiming to achieve net zero by 2050

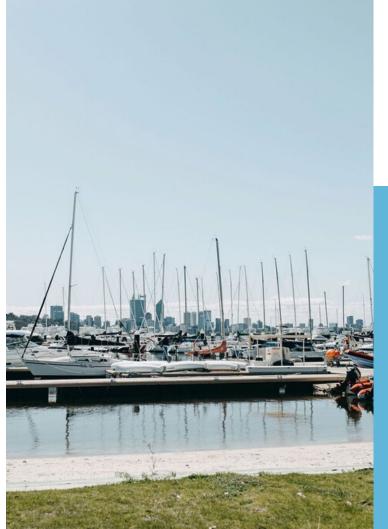
Measures: Have a Sustainability Policy by July 2024
