Eligibility to Serve as a General Committee Member of Royal Perth Yacht Club of WA (Inc)

Section 39 and 127 of the Associations Incorporation Act 2015 exclude a person from being on the General Committee without special approval from the Commissioner for Consumer Protection if they:

- a) are bankrupt or their affairs are under insolvency laws;
- b) have been convicted of an indictable offence in relation to the formation or management of a body corporate in the last five years;
- c) have been convicted of an offence involving fraud or dishonesty punishable by a least three months imprisonment in the last five years; or
- d) have been convicted of an offence under section 127 of the Act, where a person has allowed an association to operate while insolvent in the last five years.

It is the responsibility of each individual nominating for a committee position, rather than the Association, to ensure that they are eligible.
